

Case Study – Mt Sinai College, Maroubra



Mt Sinai College was undertaking major additions to their school and the architect made enquiries with us as to the possibility of having a clock on the school. A clock is a fairly straight forward thing, but we saw an opportunity to create something unique. We proposed a number of different designs, including a Hebrew dial – we understand this to be unique in Australia.

This is an example of creating an iconic clock which is both a teaching aid and a source of pride for the students whilst being representative of their language and culture.

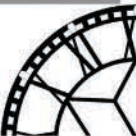




The design was drawn up using CAD and the indicators were laser cut from 20mm thick stainless steel. These were then affixed 50mm from the blank wall thus creating a shadow effect to further enhance the dial. This was in a similar style to the name of the college as shown in the pictures.

We utilised the Bodet 2M intelligent mechanism – this means that the mechanism self corrects after power interruptions and also automatically adjusts for daylight savings, requiring no attention from school staff.
